Student records expire at the end of each currently enrolled semester.	Non-student records typically expire one year from date of issue.	There are exceptions for individuals who are on campus for shortened time periods, and their records will be set to expire as a reflection of said time period.	Non-enrolled students who fill out the non-enrolled form will receive applicable student privileges, which will then grant them ability to check out equipment.	Non-enrolled students declining to fill out the non-enrolled form will be converted from "expired" to "Community" user and will have Community privileges until they are taking classes.
